Children's Healthcare of Atlanta announces big support building for new campus (Rendering)

Progress is humming along at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta's future Brookhaven campus, where the health system is planning an up to \$1.3 billion replacement hospital.

On March 22, Children's announced a 348,000-square-foot support building and parking deck for employees that will rise at the north end of the planned North Druid Hills campus along an Interstate 85 frontage road. Older office buildings on the site currently are being razed to make way for the new building, and employees who worked in those buildings have been relocated to nearby office buildings in the interim.

Site work and construction on the support building will commence as soon as demolition is complete.

The new building will offer Children's employees amenities such as dining, a coffee shop, a fitness center, a health clinic and outdoor work, meeting and dining spaces.

On March 22, Children's announced a 348,000-square-foot support building and parking deck for employees that will rise at the north end of the planned North Druid Hills campus along an Interstate 85 frontage road. Construction of the building and deck are slated to wrap in the first quarter of 2020. When the campus is complete in 2025, employees will easily be able to access the new hospital, the Center for Advanced Pediatrics and other parts of the new campus without using nearby surface streets.
